Search tips: Type a keyword and **CLICK** the radio button before **NHTI-Concord** to find materials in this building. Click **SEARCH** for a list of titles. Scan the list. **CLICK** the title to review an entry. This record will provide library locations and subject headings. **CLICK** a subject heading to find more items about the same topic

Examples of keywords: Nursing, clinical nursing, pediatric nursing, surgical nursing psychology, cross-cultural nursing

Browsing: College libraries organize collections by the Library of Congress Classification system that uses letters and numbers for a subject. The LC call number appears on the spine of a book, DVD cases and other materials. The following LC classes will be helpful:

RT – for Nursing, R – for Medicine, QM – for Anatomy
