Search tips: Search for books in the library catalog (see also General Research Guide). Start with a keyword or subject search. Select Concord as your location. When you find an interesting book, look at the subject headings in the record.

By selecting any one of those links, you can refine your search to include all books with that particular subject heading. Be sure to write down shelf location and call number to locate the book.

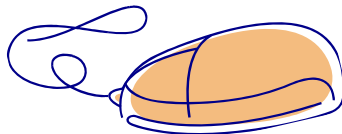
Magazine and Journals

EBSCOHost Provides online access to articles, e-books, and reference books. Create your personal MyEBSCOhost account to save and organize your research with folders, save preferences, save and retrieve search history.

The My Research feature lets you save documents you find useful and view details from your searches during your ProQuest session. You can then print a bibliography and email or export several documents at once.
