Search tips: Start with a keyword search. When you find an interesting book, look at the subject headings in the record. By selecting any one of those links, you can refine your search to include all books with that particular subject heading.

Examples of keywords: radiology, radiography, radiologic technology, tomography, medical radiology, clinical radiology, radiographic positioning

Browsing: You can also browse the shelves at the Library. The books in the Library are organized by the Library of Congress Classification system, which uses letters and numbers as a code for a subject. This code is referred to the *call number*. The following LC classes will be helpful to you: **R895- R920 for Medical Radiology, RC - Internal Medicine, RK - Dentistry, QM for Human Anatomy, RC - Internal Medicine**
