Building Designation and Space Usage

Purpose: This document outlines specific designations for building usage, identifies open lab spaces, and areas that are closed for use during the Fall semester. The objective is to limit movement between buildings, and manage space to have effective COVID-19 mitigation strategies.

Academic and Academic Support Space Designations

Academic facilities have been designated for primary space usage based on academic programs, support functions, and to address specific program concerns due to both program requirements and COVID-19-specific requirements.

Little Hall

- Primary usage for on-site STEM programs
- Computer labs available for STEM programs, zoom lectures

Grappone Hall

- 1st floor Designated primarily for on-site nursing program usage
- 2nd floor Designated primarily for on-site Education and other program usage
- Computer lab available for Grappone Hall programs, zoom lectures.

MacRury Hall

- **South Wing** Designated primarily for on-site Allied Health Program use, limited use for non-Allied Health programs
