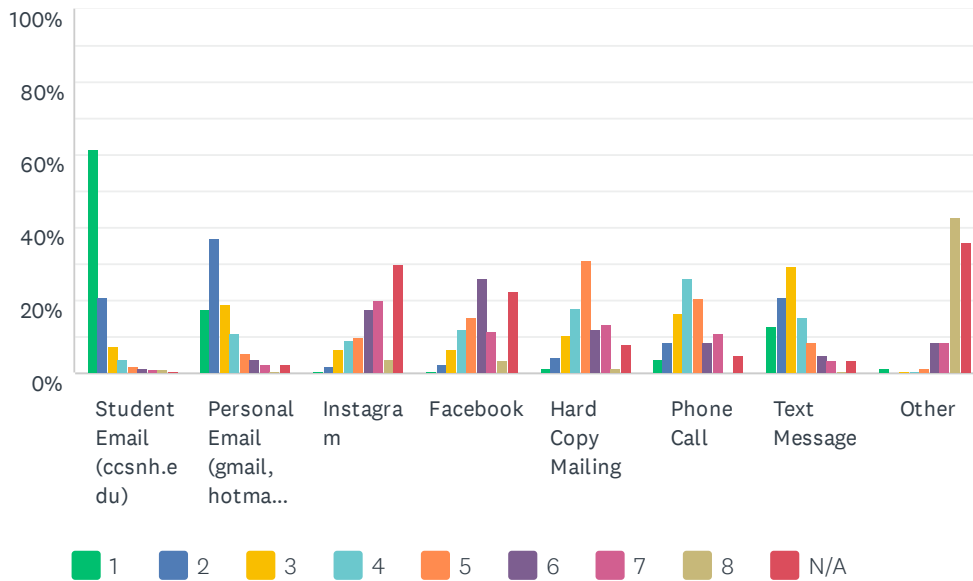


# Q1 What is the best way for you to receive information from NHTI? (please rank in order your preference)

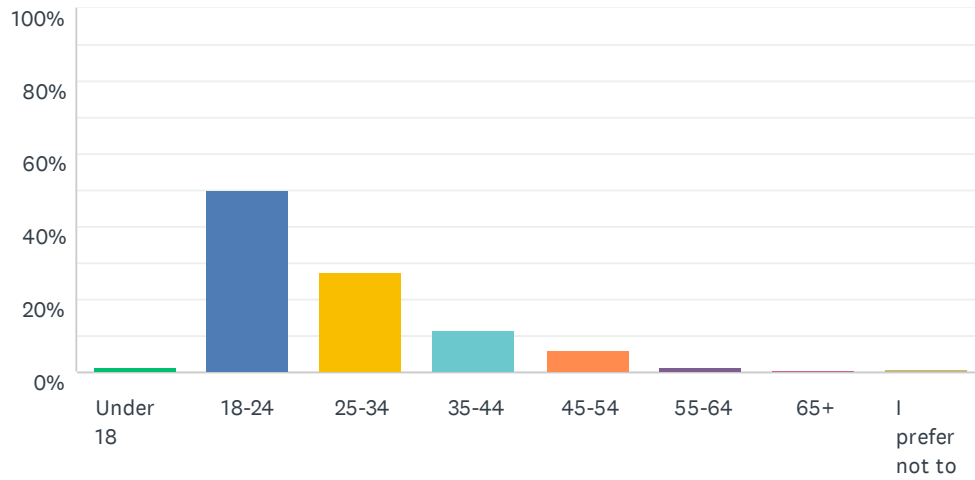

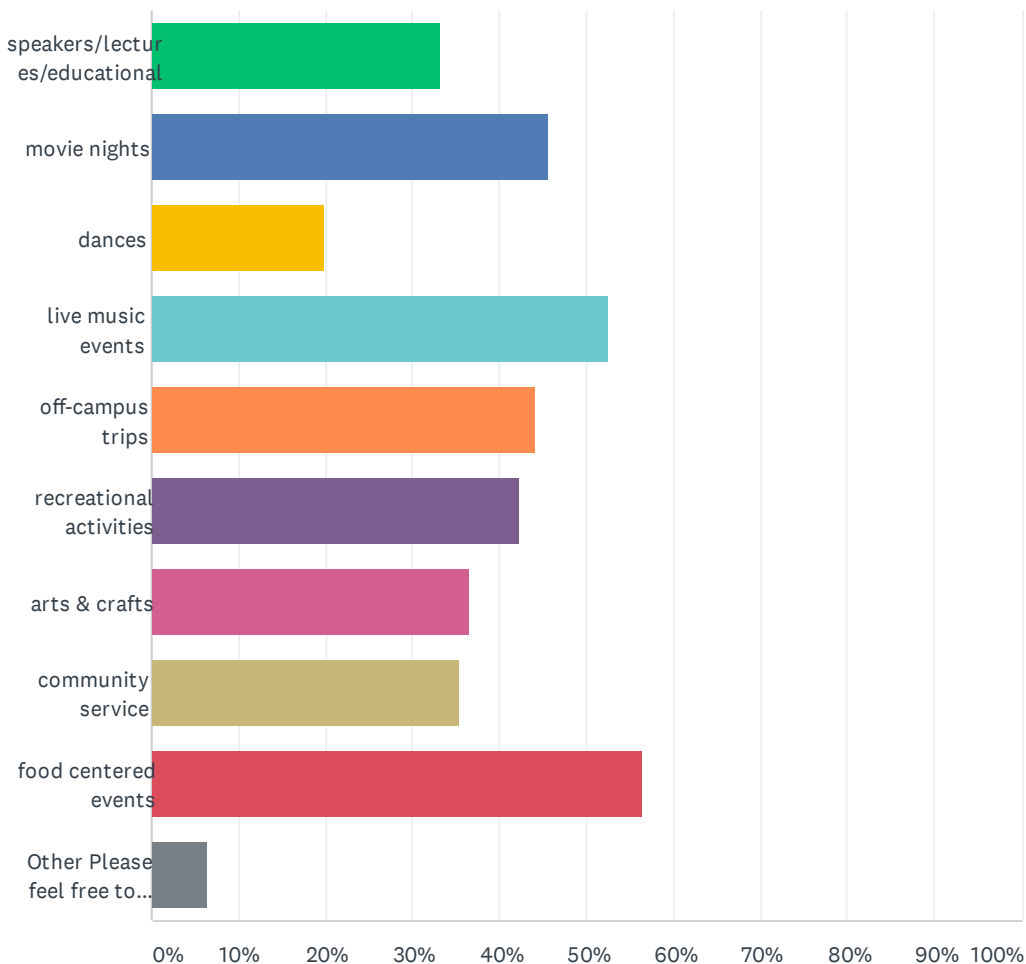

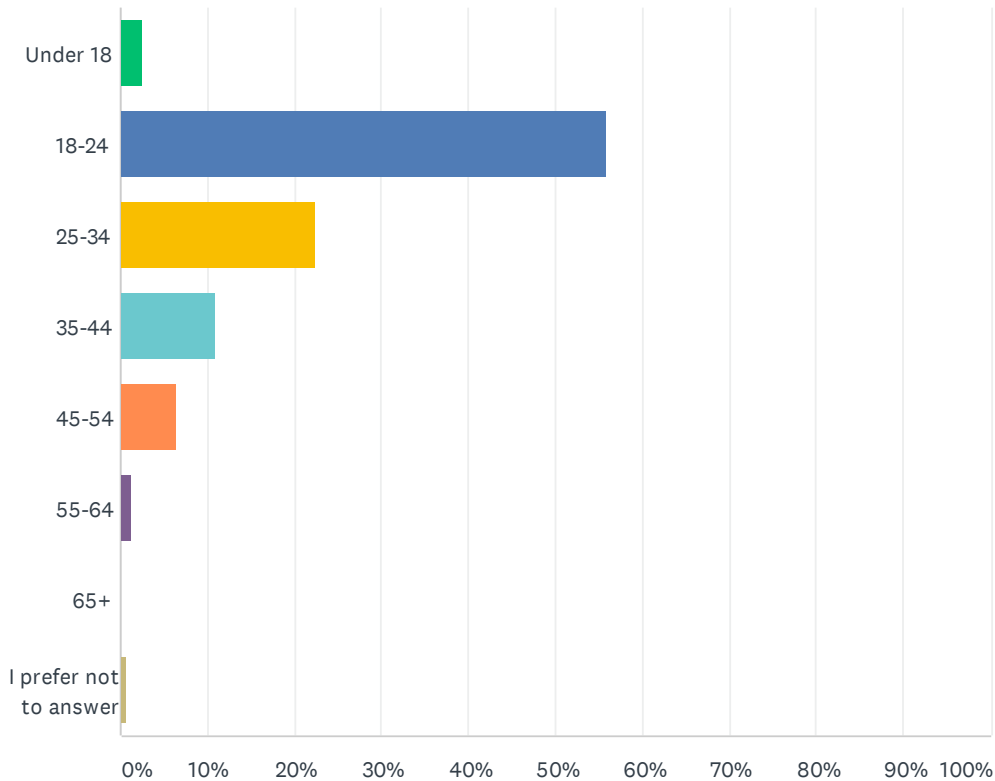
