

Submission Guidelines

Content

Record yourself demonstrating some talent, such as playing an instrument, tap dancing, doing a painting time-lapse, etc.

Keep the content appropriate for a general audience, or at the very least PG.

Technical Details

Videos should be around 1-3 minutes, and not exceed 4 minutes.

Please use one of the following video file formats:

Miscellaneous

Submissions will be accepted from February 16th to March 2nd at 11:59 PM, and are open to any students attending either LRCC or NHTI. A student may only enter one submission, either individually or in a group.

Email your video file, along with your first and last names, home town, phone number, preferred contact email and which school you're attending to NHStudentSenateEvents@gmail.com.

All persons included in the video will have to complete and submit a video use consent form, which can be solicited at the above email address.

The complete show will be premiered on YouTube on March 23rd, 2021, after which, until March 26th at 11:59, viewers will be able to vote for their favorite acts via a survey, thereby selecting winners for the various awards. Winners will be announced the following Sunday, March 28th, at noon.

Prizes will be awarded as follows: a grand prize (\$500), two 2nd place awards (\$250 each, one from each school), and two 3rd place awards (\$100 each, one from each school). Other prizes may be added at the discretion of the LRCC-NHTI Student Senate Officers.
