Now Hiring Lynx Navigators

Lynx Navigators will be peer to peer mentors who assist our students in different ways throughout the semester. First they'll work to extend the hours and services of the Help Desk usually seen in our halls at the start of each semester. For example, at the beginning of the year they'll help other students access their NHTI online resources, find their building or classroom, front offices or log into Mathlab. As the semester goes on, Navigators will support students who are struggling in classes, having difficulty making friends, or need help with tutoring or finding resources.

This is an excellent resume builder and a way to earn additional income while already on campus. Students applying for the position will be required to get a faculty reference. These positions are Covid grant-funded at \$13.24 an hour and not part of work-study. They also require a flexible schedule at 15 hours per week.
