Opening Day Spoiled by Knights Who Defeat Lynx 20-1

HAVERHILL, MA — The NHTI baseball season got off to a rocky start following a 20-1 defeat at the hands of Northern Essex CC. The Knights bats started hot taking a 8-0 advantage in the third inning and put the game out of reach.

Aaron Baker (Webster, NH) was the only Lynx player to reach base multiple times drawing three walks. **Jacob Cogswell** (Kingston, NH) registered a 1-for-3 day with a run scored while **Jonathan Demers** (Berlin, NH) went 1-for-3. **Colby Garcia** (Loudon, NH) tallied the only RBI for NHTI.

On the mound **Cogswell** picked up the loss on the mound for the Lynx throwing three innings giving up eight runs on eight hits with one walk. **Gabriel Rivas** (Queens, NY) threw one inning giving up three runs on two hits and a walk, while picking up the first strikeout of the year for the Lynx. **Demers** followed with an inning and two-thirds giving up four runs on four hits with one strikeout and one base on balls. **Cody Grant** (East Ryegate, VT) followed throwing over the span of an inning giving up three runs on three hits. **Jacob Burghardt** (Strafford, NH) finished off the game going one-third innings giving up a pair of runs on two hits with a free pass.

Ronald Luke picked up the win for NECC throwing two innings of work with four strikeouts. Nicholas White led the offense for the Knights going 2-for-3 with a homerun and three RBIs.

The next contest for the Baseball team will be on April 17th when they host the Herons.
