Lynx Blow Past Knights by a 76-61 Final

CONCORD, NH — The NHTI Lynx finish the season strong with 76-61 win over Northern Essex CC. **Kevin Newton-Delgado** (Hopkinton, NH) starred for the Lynx registering a stat-filling game with a career-high 24 points (9-13 FG, 0-2 3-FG, 6-9 FT), 19 rebounds (11 offensive rebounds) and a pair of blocks.

The Lynx trailed by a 38-37 score heading into the break before outscoring the Knights by 16 points in the second half (39-23) to lift NHTI to a victory. Rebounds were the story of this game as the Lynx dominated on the glass outrebounding the Knights 64-31 including a whopping 25 offensive rebounds.

Other notable performances for NHTI include **Shaquille Barrett** (Houston, TX) who continued his stellar season with 18 points (7-15 FG, 2-5 3-FG, 2-5 FT), 12 rebounds and three assists. **Sean Menard** (Chichester, NH) tallied 12 points (4-10 FG, 2-8 3-FG, 2-2 FT) and three steals, while **Saeer Miller** (Philadelphia, PA) notched eight points (3-10 FG, 0-1 3-FG, 2-5 FT), 14 rebounds and five assists.

Jeremiah Melendez led NECC with 26 points (8-16 FG, 0-4 3-FG, 10-13 FT) and 10 rebounds

For the team statistics the Lynx shot 39.1% from the floor with four three-pointers edging the Knights who shot 28.2% with eight made triples. NHTI dished 13 assists over NECC with eight. The Lynx lost the turnover battle forcing only 14 turnovers for 17 points while the Knights had 25 takeaways for 15 points.
