## Lynx Baseball Edged by Herons 14-4



CONCORD, NH — The Lynx Baseball team dropped a contest with the Herons on Saturday by a 14-4 final. The Herons started the offensive early jumping ahead by a 4-0 lead heading into the fourth inning. The Herons continued to score tallying five more runs in the fifth and sixth frames. NHTI had their best inning in the bottom of the sixth scoring four runs. The Herons would score five more scores in the final two stanzas to get the double-digit victory.

**Kevin Newton-Delgado** (Hopkinton, NH) had a solid day with the bat going 2-for-4 with a run scored and a walk. **Jonathan Demers** (Berlin, NH) registered the first extra base hit for the Lynx with a 1-for-2 day with a double. **Cameron Anderson** (Bristol, NH) went 1-for-4 with an RBI, while **Jacob Cogswell** (Kingston, NH), **Jacob Burghardt** (Strafford, NH) and **Lucas Rose** (Dover, NH) registered an RBI each.

On the mound for NHTI **Cogswell** picked up the loss going five, innings giving up six runs (three earned) on seven hits, three walks while punching out nine. **Burghardt** followed throwing a third of an inning allowing three runs (two earned) on two hits and a free pass. **Newton-Delgado** closed the day pitching three and two-thirds innings of work surrendering five runs on five hits and five walks with three strikeouts.
