NHTI Has Nine Alumni Selected to YSCC Twin All-Decade Men's Cross Country Team

CONCORD, NH — Today, the Yankee Small College Conference (YSCC) announced the Men's Cross Country Twin All-Decade Team featuring nine NHTI Alumni. Chris Apkarian, Tyler Harding, Graham Hayslip, Nacho Hernando, Niall Kimball, Branden McCoo, Quinn Parker, Andrew Shepherd, and James Stockwell were honored for their remarkable play at NHTI. "This Amazing group of NHTI recipients. Every athlete has had an incredible career playing and leading our teams in many ways", said Paul Hogan, Athletic Director "I want to send congratulations to each player and to thank them for their many contributions our fine college and athletic program."

Chris Apkarian ran well for NHTI highlighted by an exciting 2010. Apkarian won the YSCC Conference Championship in 2010 locking in a YSCC All-Conference selection. Apkarian also was selected as a USCAA All-American for an outstanding year.

Tyler Harding was an outstanding competitor at NHTI. In his three years running Harding made the YSCC All-Conference team twice first in 2010 and then again in 2012.

Graham Hayslip continues to have an impact with NHTI today. Hayslip is a co-head coach of the program and was a stellar runner in his competitive days. Hayslip was the 2009 YSCC Conference Champion securing a YSCC All-Conference selection.

Nacho Hernando has the best finish for the men's cross country program back in 2013 where he placed second. Hernando was a two-time YSCC All-Conference member, winning the YSCC Conference Championship in 2013. Hernando was selected to the NHTI Athletics Hall of Fame in 2019 for his outstanding career at NHTI.

Niall Kimball brought a lot of success to NHTI in 2016. Kimball won the 2016 YSCC Conference Championship, earning him YSCC All-Conference honors. Kimball also was named team MVP in 2016.

Branden McCoo always competed at a high level for NHTI. McCoo was named to the YSCC All-Conference in 2015 and 2016 while being named a USCAA All-American in 2015. McCoo excelled in the classroom as well being named a USCAA Academic All-American in 2016.

Quinn Parker starred at NHTI in 2013 and 2014. Parker was named to the YSCC All-Conference team both years while also doing well in the classroom. In 2014 Parker was a USCAA Academic All-American.

Andrew Shepherd brought another YSCC Conference Championship to NHTI in 2018 where he finished in first place. Shepherd also was named a YSCC All-Conference member twice in 2017 and again in 2018. Shepherd continued his success in his classes being named a USCAA Academic All-American in 2018.

James Stockwell ran very well for NHTI in 2011. Stockwell was named the team MVP in 2011 as well as winning the YSCC Conference Championship, earning him a YSCC All-Conference selection.
