The NHTI Education Associate Degree program prepares you for a wide range of exciting and interesting opportunities working with children both inside and outside of a classroom environment. You'll learn how to work in elementary, middle, and secondary schools and gain clinical field-based experiences from the very first course. These experiences combined with the opportunity to work with high quality faculty, prepare you for further college study and/or jobs in schools or communities.

Academic Options

Education courses are offered in the day, evening, and online with some taking place in K-12 schools beginning in your first semester. You gain experience in many educational and learning environments. The internship opportunities often lead to job offers. And, the Education program has transfer agreements with a variety of institutions both in and out of state and will help you transition to earn your bachelor's degree.

Career Opportunities

The strong interpersonal and organizational skills of education majors translate well to a multitude of fields. You can work with students, including those with special needs, or pursue advanced degrees for teaching jobs in math, science, and ESOL. Job prospects tend to be higher in urban and rural school districts.

Transfer Opportunities

NHTI has articulation agreements with many local institutions, including Keene State College, New England College, Plymouth State University, Rivier University, Southern New Hampshire University, University of New England, and Walden University. Many education students have also successfully transferred out of state to institutions in Florida, Vermont, Massachusetts, and Maryland.
