



Articulation Agreement

NHTI-CONCORD'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE

and

CONCORD REGIONAL TECHNICAL CENTER

Beginning with the 2020-2021 academic year, a successful completer of the following courses taken through the Concord Regional Technical Center at Concord High will be accepted by NHTI-Concord into the Associate of Science in Early Childhood Education or the Associate of Science in Early Care and Education for Young Children with Disabilities Program.

The student must meet the following requirements:

Earn a C or better in the course;

Follow the proper protocol and requirements for obtaining the college credit through Southern New Hampshire University and have the transcript sent to NHTI-Concord; and

Complete required Key Assessments to meet the NHTI Accreditation standards for the course(s) being transferred.

These courses will be accepted into the NHTI ECE and EYCD programs to meet the competencies and the student will be awarded the college credit for those courses. Students who have these courses transferred into the ECE and EYCD Programs at NHTI will still be responsible for applying to and being accepted into the program and meeting all of the program requirements for ECE and EYCD students.


Please note that the NHTI ECE and EYCD students must complete a criminal background and fingerprinting upon entrance into the ECE and EYCD Programs.
