General Expectations

NHTI – Concord’s Community College will:

- Provide staff to assist with student/parent orientation.
- Offer the opportunity for student visits to the campus.
- Develop peer mentors so that the Manchester School of Technology students can shadow NHTI students.

Manchester School of Technology will:

- Provide a program that integrates academic and vocational-technical education.
- Expose students to career options and the opportunity available for articulation with NHTI.
- Provide counseling for students and parents interested in postsecondary education.
- Coordinate with NHTI faculty to review curriculum.
- Sponsor activities with NHTI when possible.

Students will:

- Visit with NHTI faculty, students and programs in areas related to career interests.
- Obtain program instructor’s recommendation.
- Maintain necessary GPA with a 90% attendance rate.

Terms and Conditions


- Prior to graduating from Manchester School of Technology, student will be able to apply for admission to NHTI.
- Students enrolled in the high school Design Communication program may have the opportunity to earn dual high school/college credit if/when the following criteria are met:
 - A review of the high school transcript indicates attainment of skills and standard comparable to postsecondary courses
 - An attendance record of no less than 90%
 - A grade point average of 2.5 or higher
- Students meeting the above criteria in Manchester School of Technology’s Design Communication program will also be eligible for transfer credit for NHTI’s ARET 103C Architectural Graphics & Sketching.




