Lynx Volleyball Splits Opening Matches at Paul Smith College



PAUL SMITHS, NY – The Lynx Women's Volleyball returned to competitive action on Saturday splitting a pair of matches at Paul Smith's College in New York. NHTI fell to Paul Smith's College by a 3-0 (23-25, 13-25, 23-25) final before leaving with a 3-0 (25-16, 25-15, 25-13) victory over Hudson Valley Community College.

In the first match the Bobcats were victorious in two close finishes in the first and third set. **Jessica Allen** (Saugus, MA) led the Lynx with 13 assists, six assisted blocks as well a kill and a dig. **Emma Ferguson** (Concord, NH) led NHTI in kills registering a career-high seven with an assist and three assisted blocks.

In the final match of the weekend the Lynx were on the attack controlling the Vikings in every set leaving with the win. **Molly Strong** (New Boston, NH) led the way with 13 kills, five solo blocks, three digs and a pair of service aces. **Danna Paola Mejia Melo** (Manchester, NH) led NHTI in both contests in digs tallying 11 against Hudson Valley CC from the libero position.

The Lynx Volleyball team will next host Great Bay CC on September 15th.
