

Certificate candidates must have completed a two-year AMA or AMA equivalent Allied Health training program that's patient care-related or have a B.S. You'll complete hands-on training in labs and clinical rotations throughout northern New England taught by registered diagnostic medical sonographers. Upon completion of the 16-month program, you'll get a professional certificate in Diagnostic Medical Sonography and be eligible for the National Registry Exam.

Career Opportunities

Employment in diagnostic medical sonography is projected to grow 17% through 2028¹. Potential jobs include pediatric/musculoskeletal/vascular sonography, abdominal/breast/cardiac sonography, and obstetric/gynecologic sonography in hospitals and private clinics. Career opportunities are available throughout New England and the U.S.
