Accounting is a critical component of every type and size of business and industry including government, healthcare, education, not-for-profit, and military organizations. Accounting employees provide much of the information used by these organizations to make critical financial decisions. We also offer credit transfer options to 4-year colleges and universities. This degree is accredited by the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs.

Full-Time and Part-Time Paths

Accelerated programs offer the flexibility and adaptability to be a full-time or part-time student and to start during any given NHTI semester of courses (see program paths). You

can begin and finish your degree when it's most accessible for you, and we are here to help you at every step along the way.

Career Opportunities

This program prepares you for entry-level jobs in finance, accounting, and business. Employment of accountants and auditors is projected to grow 6% through 2028 and is tied to the health of the overall economy; as the economy grows, workers will be needed to prepare and examine financial records. This program prepares you for jobs like accounts payable/receivable clerk, tax preparer, billing/accounting/auditing clerk, bookkeeper, and financial analyst.

Salary Potential

The entry-level salary for those with an associate degree in Accounting is \$19.35 per hour, or \$40,240 per year.
