

Authorization to Release Information

The Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law that influences record keeping in most colleges and universities. Popularly known as the "Buckley Amendment," it requires that the educational records of students in colleges and universities receiving Department of Education funds remain confidential. The Buckley Amendment allows others to access a student's educational records only if the student consents.
