Verified Microcredential Certificate

This course provides a reference manual that supports the Delta Dental employee's daily work. A web-based learning site is available to enhance and reinforce the weekly instruction. This includes survey/assessments, learning objectives, and course materials and resources. Participants are also asked to take a post-training survey to measure the understanding and retention of the course curriculum.
