

NHTI Remote Placement Exams – OHM Direct Login Access

Student Guide: Directions to Enroll in NHTI Remote Placement Exams

To take your mathematics placement exam or English survey, you must enroll in a “course” at Lumen OHM. There is no enrollment fee. Course components include: Orientation to Lumen OHM software, practice tests, and the Placement Exam/survey. You must achieve a score of 75% or higher on the Math Placement Exam to register for your desired mathematics course at NHTI. Although the Lumen software attaches points to the English survey, it is not a test. You need not concern yourself with a score. The results of your exam or survey will be sent to your NHTI advisor, who will contact you to discuss your course registration options. To access the Lumen OHM course, follow these steps:

1. Visit ohm.lumenlearning.com.
2. Click “Enroll in a New Course.”
3. When prompted, enter the Course ID 68066. There is no enrollment key – leave this field blank.
4. Click “Enroll.” You should see the confirmation on the right:
5. Click “Enroll” again.
6. Create an account by specifying a username and password, your first and last name, and your NHTI student email address.

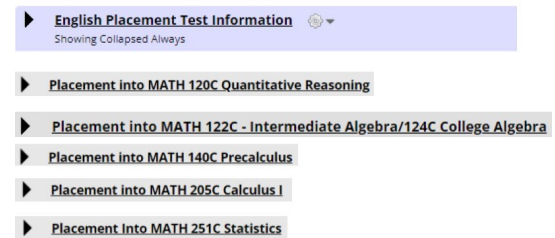
Once You Are Enrolled

English Placement Exam

- **Choose:** Click the link to the English Placement Test Information for your exam.

Mathematics Placement Exams

- **Required:** Complete the “Orientation to Lumen OHM Software” with at least 50% accuracy to gain access to your intended placement exam.
- **Choose:** Click the link corresponding to the course recommended by your advisor.



Recommended: Practice for your intended placement exam using the practice test provided. You can take the practice test as many times as you like until you are ready to take the Placement Exam.

Schedule: Set up a date/time to take the placement exam by contacting NHTI’s Academic Center for Excellence (NHTIace@ccsnh.edu). You’ll be given a password to take the placement exam remotely. If you experience any technical difficulties, contact Prof. Daniel Shagena (dshagena@ccsnh.edu).

On the Day of Your Placement Exam

You will be taking this exam remotely in one sitting. You should make sure you have a block of time reserved to complete the exam: 3 hours for MATH120C, MATH140C, MATH205C, and MATH251C; 40 minutes each for MATH122C and MATH124C. We recommend the following for greatest success:

- *Quiet testing environment:* Turn off your phone, find a quiet space where you can focus
- *Use your tools:* Paper and pencil to write out your work, calculator (TI-84 recommended)

Written Work Requirement: You’re required to submit written work, except for the MATH122C and MATH124C exams, showing how you obtained the solution to each problem. Scan or take photos of the written work. If you used the TI-84 calculator to solve a problem, take a photo of the calculator screen. Be sure these photos are legible and that the problem number on the exam is clearly identified. Paste these pictures into a document, then upload the document in the appropriate place in Lumen OHM. Your written work will be considered in your placement exam results.
