

# Accurate and Proven Methodology

Upon completion of this microcredential, students will be prepared to take the Radiation Health and Safety exam and, once successfully passed, will have complied with the New Hampshire Board of Dental Examiners (NHBODE) rules. After completing 3,500 hours of on-the-job training at dental practices, dental assistants will then be eligible to take additional Dental Assisting National Board (DANB) testing.

# Microcredential Topics and Schedule

### Session 1 POI/Introduction to Dental Assisting

This course is designed to prepare dental assistants to perform a preliminary oral inspection (PIO) on patients and includes taking

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medical and dental histories, obtaining and reading vital signs, basic oral anatomy and terminology, and dental charting. CEUs: 6 hours

Prerequisites and required documents: Employment Verification Form confirming 400 hours of chair-side experience

#### Session 2 Infection Control Practice

Course topics include barrier techniques, limiting contamination, hand washing, handling of sharps, sterilization, disinfection, and disposal of waste materials. CEUs: 6 hours

### Session 3 Techniques in Radiology for the Dental Assistant

Online lectures and demonstrations are coordinated with lab practice on manikins and patients to develop mastery of digital dental radiographic techniques, including mounting and evaluating images. Emphasis is placed on patient and operator protection and equipment function. CEUs: 12 hours

Prerequisites and required documents: Completion of POI and ICP courses; proof of liability insurance

#### Session 4 Individual Excellence

This course teaches 12 vital career-enhancing skills to establish a clear career path and use skills like interpersonal communication and time management to achieve goals. Students learn how to use creativity and problem-solving skills to work through adversity. 24 course hours

## Session 5 Career Pathways and Exam Prep for Dental Assistants

This course will cover the legal requirements set forth by the NH Board of Dental Examiners (NHBODE), career options and how to become qualified in other areas, and study and exam preparation for the DANB Radiology Health and Safety exam. 4 course hours

Prerequisites and required documents: Employment Verification Form confirming 400 hours of chair-side experience; completion of radiology course approved by NHBODE
