From the North or South

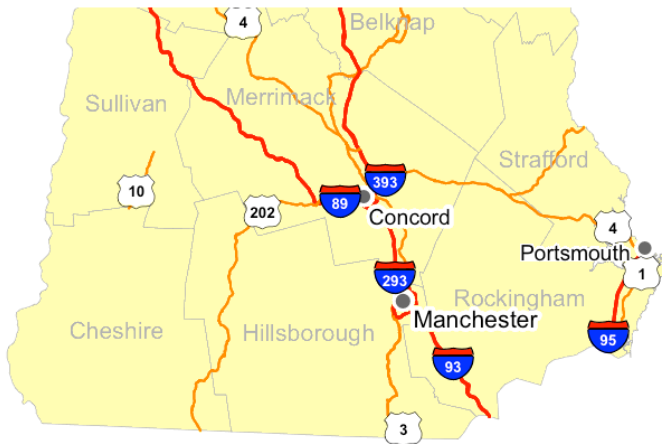
Take I-93 and use Exit 15 East to I-393. Use Exit 1 and follow the signs.
