

ATI: Fundamentals Exam for Advanced Standing Transfer Nursing Candidates Academic Year 2023-24

Students applying for transfer for advanced standing into the Nursing program at NHTI - Concord's Community College are required to complete the Assessment Technology Institute (ATI): Fundamentals of Nursing Examination. The ATI: Fundamentals of Nursing Exam will test the examinee on their knowledge of nursing theory and practice, and will give the examinee and the Nursing department an assessment of the student's preparedness to begin the second semester of the Nursing ADN program.

The exam will be computer-based, and examinees will have 65 minutes to complete the exam. Students will need to receive a **Proficiency Level of 2 or higher** to be considered for admission for Advanced Standing Transfer into the Nursing program.

Fees:

Examinees will be required to pay a \$25 exam administration fee to NHTI when registering for the exam; students will also be required to pay an exam fee of \$30 to ATI directly on-line via credit card on the day of testing.

Examinees must bring a credit card to pay the separate ATI Exam fee on the day of the exam; no other forms of payment can be accepted.

How to Register:

The Academic Center for Excellence (ACE) at NHTI will administer this examination on **Friday**, **September 29**, **2023 at 1:30 pm** with check in at 1:00 pm. The attached ATI Fundamental Exam registration form and exam administration fee must be *received* in the Admissions Office no later than the registration deadline listed for the exam.

Registration will be limited to the first 10 students. If you have an outstanding financial obligation at any of the CCSNH colleges, your registration will not be processed until it is resolved.

Students with disabilities who are requesting special accommodations for testing must contact Joanna Willis, Coordinator of Disabilities Services, at 603-230-4027 or jwillis@ccsnh.edu to learn about the process for requesting accommodations and providing the required documentation to support the request. Students must allow at least two weeks to complete the approval process.

Students will receive an email confirmation from ACE approx. 1 week prior to the exam date outlining what to expect on exam day; this email would include the testing location on-campus, what to bring with you on the day of the exam. If you need to cancel your exam, contact the ACE at 603 230-4027. Please note that the **exam administration fee is non-refundable**.
