Times:	10:00 am
Diplomas:	Diplomas will be mailed directly to students and will not be received by the Registrar's Office.
Certificates:	Students who have completed a certificate program will be invited to participate/walk in this year's commencement ceremonies.
Volunteers:	We will need volunteers from NHTI's faculty and staff to welcome guests, find parking, etc.
Faculty:	One department faculty member will lead students into the gymnasium. They will sit with the students and lead them to the stage, where the faculty member will then congratulate students alongside the platform party. Every program needs a faculty member; if there is no faculty member for every program, faculty will not be participating on stage.
