

## Estimated Cost of Attendance for International Students Academic Year 2025-2026

This estimate of education and living expenses is for the 2025-2026 academic year only, and does not include additional academic expenses that may be required for programs that include clinical and/or lab fees or attendance in a summer term. **Please note: all charges are subject to change without notice.**

If you will be living **on-campus** (in a residence hall), your financial document must show a minimum of **\$27,348**.

If you will be living **off-campus** (in an apartment or with family or friends), your financial document must show a minimum of **\$28,532**.

1. **Tuition and Mandatory Fees** are based on the current tuition rate of \$505 per credit hour with comprehensive fees of \$25 per credit;  $(\$505 + \$25) \times 12 \text{ credits per semester} \times 2 \text{ semesters} = \underline{\$12,720}$ .
  - International students must enroll in a **minimum of 12 credits** of coursework per semester to maintain F-1 status unless otherwise approved and documented by the PDSO (Primary Designated School Official). A reduced credit load must be approved by a DSO and noted in the SEVIS record (the federal Student and Exchange Visitor Information System).
  - Please note that most programs will require that students take more than the minimum of 12 credits per semester to graduate on-time, so actual tuition and fee costs may be higher.
  
2. **Living Expenses**
  - **For on campus students:**

Room (double occupancy):	$\$3,726 \times 2 \text{ semesters} =$	\$7,452
Board (19 meals per week):	$\$2,088 \times 2 \text{ semesters} =$	\$4,176
Resident Activity Fee:	$\$75 \times 2 \text{ semesters} =$	\$150
Incidentals, i.e. general expenses/miscellaneous spending =		\$1,500
Total =		<b><u>\$13,278</u></b>
  - **For off-campus residents:**  
Students living off-campus must budget for room and board = **\$14,462**
  - **Any additional F-2 dependents** (spouse, children) must also be included in financial support documents:
    - **\$9,900** = first dependent
    - **\$3,500** = each additional dependent
  
3. **Academic Instruction, Clinic and Materials Fees** (estimated and not included in total)  
Additional fees may be assessed based on the specific major and courses a student enrolls in. An Academic Instruction Fee is charged to all students taking lab, clinical, field experience, or practicum courses. A Clinical surcharge of \$500 per semester will be charged for students enrolled in Allied Health Programs. Studio and Materials fees may be charged for art and theatre courses. 4. **Miscellaneous Books and Supplies** vary by academic department.  
For example: Business Program = \$600 per semester + \$150 calculator (one-time fee) = **\$1,350**
